

2011 CNSA Ontario Regional Conference: “Leadership in Nursing”

Registration FAQs

1. Where is the conference being held?

The conference will be held at three different locations within downtown Toronto, depending on the specific events of the conference. The locations are:

2. When is the conference?

The CNSA 2011 Regional Conference will be held between October 21st, 2011 and October 23rd, 2011.

3. When does registration for the conference begin?

Registration begins on August 15th, 2011 through to October 10th, 2011. Please note that regular registrants will have priority in workshop selection and will receive a FREE weekend Toronto transit pass. Late registrants will receive their workshop assignment on a first come first serve basis following workshop selection for regular registrants. The dates for regular and late registration are as follows:

Regular registration: August 15th, 2011 to September 26th, 2011

Late registration: September 27th, 2011 to October 10th, 2011

4. How do I register for the conference?

Registration will be done in a three-step process.

1. Beginning August 15, 2011, you can download a [registration form](#). Mail in the required information to ATTN: CNSA, 155 College Street Suite 130, Toronto, Ontario, M5T 1P8. Cheques can be made out to Canadian Nursing Students’ Association.
2. A completed online registration survey is required prior to October 7th, 2011 to be considered a regular registrant. Your registration is considered late if your cheque is received past September 26th and/or if the online survey is completed after October 8th. A link to the online survey will be emailed to you once we receive your registration form.
3. Prior to the conference you will receive an email confirming your attendance and the conference details. Arrive at the conference with a student or government issued I.D. for your in-person registration.

5. Why is the online survey needed?

To help facilitate the organization process, an online survey is used to collect information such as workshop selection, dietary restrictions, and interests in hospital tours from participants. Therefore, it is important that conference attendees complete their registration survey by October 7th, 2011 in order to be given equal opportunity to attend their selected workshops.

6. How does workshop selection work?

If you have submitted your registration form by September 26th and completed the online registration survey by October 7th, you will be considered a regular registrant. Workshop selection will be a randomized process with an effort to place regular registrants in their preferred choices. If the registration survey is completed after October 7th, 2011, your workshops will be selected on a first come first serve basis.

7. What is the registration fee for the conference this year?
