Executive Summary

The Canadian Nursing Students' Association (CNSA) has made considerable headway as being the national voice of Canadian Nursing students. Since its previous planning session in 2006 CNSA has grown its membership, earned seats on the Board of Directors of CASN, CNA, CFNU, and been part of many national project that further Nursing Education in Canada.

At the June, and September meetings of the Board of Directors the Board and Strategic Planning Committee engaged in extensive conversation regarding the future of CNSA, the result of which is this Strategic Plan.
