This award is being offered as part of the new CNSA Legacy Fund. This is an opportunity for 10 nursing students from CNSA chapter schools in good standing to have their travel and accommodations paid for to attend the 2018 CNSA National Conference. This event will take place from January 23-27, 2018 in Nanaimo, BC where attendees will be given the opportunity to learn about the many different areas of focus in the field of nursing, and will learn the importance of collaboration within the healthcare setting. Please note that registration fee for the conference is NOT included in this award.

Application Process

Interested applicants must submit a 300-500 word essay describing themselves, their leadership goals, why they want to attend the 2018 CNSA National Conference and what they hope to bring back to their schools from the conference. Previous CNSA involvement is an asset and preference will be given to those who have never attended a CNSA National Conference.

All applications and supporting documents must be submitted to awards@cnsa.ca no later than December 3rd, 2017 at 2100 PST. Please also attach a scanned copy or screen shot of a current semester, or your most recent semester's transcript, as proof of enrolment, as well as your contact information (school, region, email address and phone number). A reminder that applications can be submitted in either English or French.

Selection Process

The awards will be divided up by region as follows:

- Ontario/Quebec Region: 3 students (priority for at least 1 student from Québec)
- Prairie Region: 2 students
- West Region: 2 students
- Atlantic Region: 2 students

In addition, one award will be reserved for a self-identified Indigenous nursing student, highlighting their work in Indigenous health and leadership.

The successful applicants must then provide proof of registration to the 2018 CNSA National Conference, and a traveler profile (template to be provided) no later than December 18th, 2017 at 0900 EST. A reminder that the event registration is NOT included in this award and successful applicants are responsible for covering the registration fee on their own.
