Part I: Opportunity to attend CNA Board and Annual General Meetings

Description of award

This award was established through the new CNSA Leadership Development Program which was created to support students in seeking out leadership opportunities within CNSA and through our stakeholders. The student selected will have the opportunity to join the CNSA President and the five Regional Directors at the Canadian Nurses Association (CNA) Annual General Meeting (AGM). Prior to the AGM, the individual selected will also be accompanying the CNSA Past President to the CNA Board of Directors Meeting. This opportunity will provide students with a better understanding of how CNA works and the impact a student's voice has at the national level. Travel, accommodation, and meals will be reimbursed according to CNSA Travel Policy. Board members from the 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 are not eligible to apply.

- Must be a student who attends a CNSA chapter school in good standing
- Must be willing to submit a one page report with pictures and/or multimedia report sharing their experience within 7 days following the event. This write-up should include a section on the voice and presence of CNSA at CNA
- Student may be required to sign a confidentiality form as per CNA.
- Must be able to travel between June 18 - 22, 2017 and to attend the events in full
