Description of award

This award was established through the new CNSA Leadership Development Program which was created to support students in seeking out leadership opportunities within CNSA and through our stakeholders. - Must be willing to submit a one page report with pictures and/or multimedia report sharing their experience within 7 days following the event. This write-up should include a section on the importance of getting involved with CNSA and pursuing leadership opportunities
- Student may be required to sign a confidentiality form as per CNSA.
- Must be able to travel between August 24-27, 2017 and to attend the meetings in full
